The 500 words entry should, where possible, detail:

- Contribution of the achievement to the circular bioeconomy on the island of Ireland
- Show unique innovation in an area that will or has led to increased benefit for the company or the industry

Top Bioeconomy Young Talent

The 500 words entry should, where possible, detail:

- Recognised/potential impact of this individual's work for the bioeconomy on island of Ireland
- Achievements of this individual in developing the bioeconomy sector

Best Food Waste Valorisation Action

The 500 words entry should, where possible, detail:

- Explaining how the food waste is upcycled / valorised into a new value-added product.
- The amount of food waste prevented from being disposed
